The event provided a comprehensive exploration of MSME schemes, financial support, digital marketing, and success habits, enriched by real-world experiences and insights from various speakers.

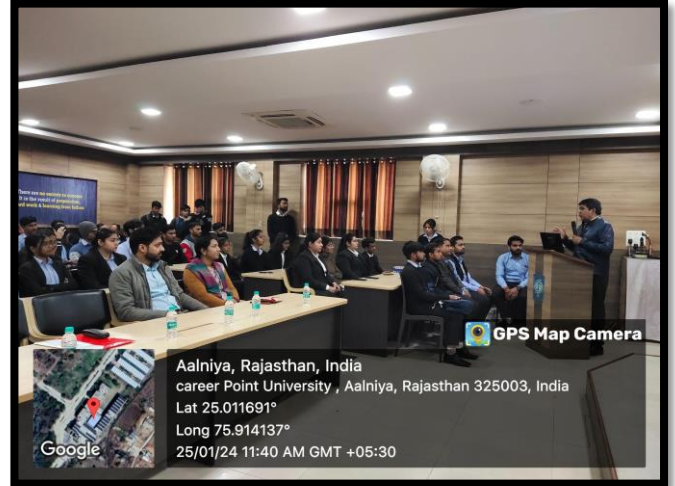

9. The Ekatra Story: A fireside talk with founder

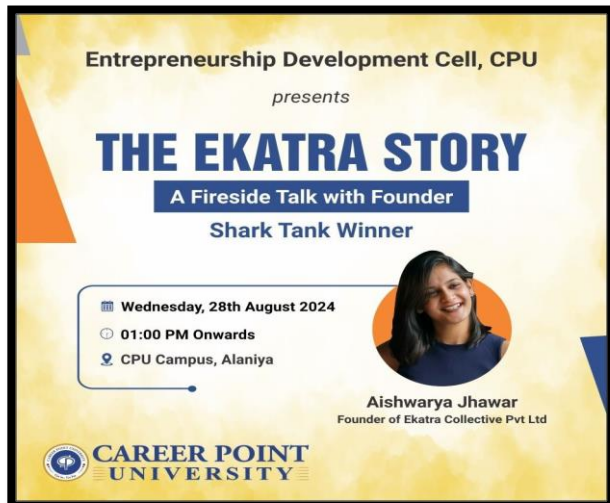
