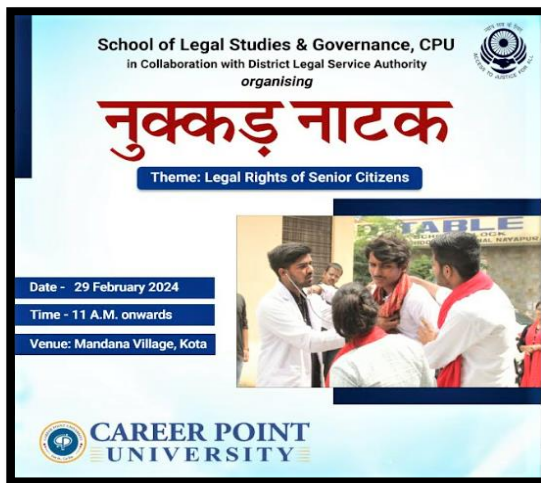

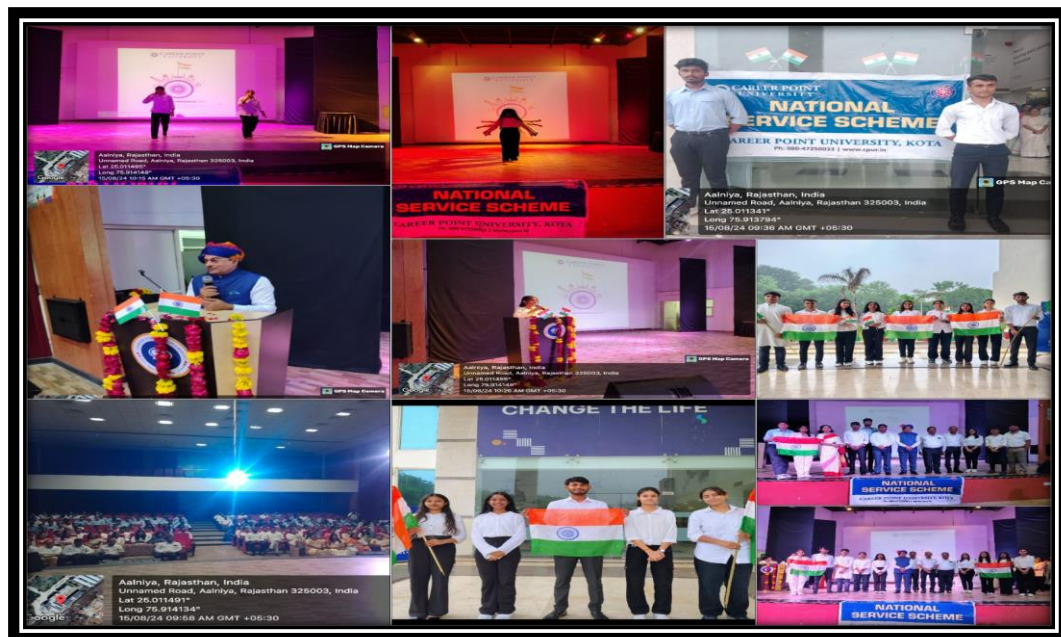
6. Awareness Drive on National Voters Day

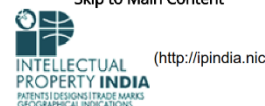
