1. Inclusion and Anti-Discrimination

- Ensure admission from all social backgrounds with mentoring and counseling support.
- Strictly implement admission policies for students with disabilities.

2. Infrastructure Support

- Lifts, automatic doors
- Ramps, railings, and accessible washrooms.
- Wheelchairs available on campus.
- Ambulance available on campus
- Separate parking
- Disabled-friendly signboards.
- Extra time and writer assistance during examinations as per University rules.
- Screen magnification and screen reader software designed for people with low vision. It enlarges text and images on the screen and reads out the content.

3. Faculty & Staff Training

- Regular disability awareness and inclusivity training for faculty, staff, and students to foster understanding and create a supportive learning environment.
- Train teachers on inclusive teaching methods that cater to diverse learning needs.
